

Caring for New Lacquer Finishes

- 1. Do not place any heavy objects for long periods of time on the furniture nor put it in full service for a period of sixty (60) days.
- 2. **Do Not** apply any cleaner or polish for at least **two months** after delivery.
- 3. You may use a **slightly** water moistened rag to dust. Dry off the surface completely when finished.
- 4. After two months of cure time you may use **Johnson's Pledge** as often as you would like but, at least three times a year to keep the finish moisturized. Be sure to spray the rag NOT the furniture. You may clean any furniture's finish that is in **good condition** with Murphy Oil Soap.

Paste waxes offer slightly more protection but maybe difficult to apply, especially on wood that has carvings. Most brand names are of equal quality.

If you choose to wax, make sure you remove all excess wax. If you can smear the wax with your finger, you have too much wax on the surface. Keep rubbing until you can't smear the wax.

Use a protective pad when writing on any furniture surface.

Lift and place objects rather than dragging them across the furniture surface.

Warning: Avoid extreme changes in temperature by arranging furniture away from radiators, heat or air vents and sunlight.
